This bibliography is a listing of titles for use with El día de los niños/El día de los libros programs and celebrations in this tool kit. It is by no means intended to be a comprehensive list of books by or about Latinos. Please refer to the section on *Selection* for information on additional sources for quality books. Age designations are not provided, although one can make general assumptions as to age-appropriateness of a particular book based on the program in which the books were included. Keep in mind, though, that children often will find satisfying reading materials at various levels and a teacher or librarian can introduce higher level books to them.
